Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion for eligibility check, examination, and evaluation of bids and post qualification based on NEA's Procurement Guidelines and Simplified Bidding procedures for Electric Cooperatives (IRR of RA 10531 for Lots 1 to 4).
5. For Lots 1 to 4, procured under Republic Act 10531 and pursuant to NEA Memorandum No. 2017-019, only those who have purchased the Bidding Documents from the BAC



Secretariat shall be allowed to participate in the Pre-Bid Conference. The Bidding Documents Fee shall be non-refundable.

6. Prospective bidders who could not attend the Pre-Bid Conference (date, time and place stated above) may still buy bid documents and join the bidding but queries after Pre-Bid Conference will no longer be entertained.
7. Bid proposals must be VAT inclusive. Sealed Eligibility Requirements, Technical, and Financial Envelopes must be submitted to the BAC Secretariat at the address given below, ON or BEFORE the scheduled Bid Opening July 22, 2026 until 12:59 PM, during which said envelopes for eligibility requirements and proposal for the respective lots will be opened and read in the presence of the bidder's representative. Late bids shall not be accepted.
8. All bids submitted must be accompanied by a bid security, in cash/cashier's check/manager's check issued by a universal/commercial bank. This bid security shall be valid for at least one hundred twenty (120) days, starting from the date of the opening.
9. The Albay Electric Cooperative, Inc. (ALECO) hereby reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to award in whole or in part, declare a failure of bidding, or not to award the contract without disclosing any reason, to the affected bidder/s.
